

LOAN

You just need your **TIU** (*University Identity Card*).

- Up to **8** copies can be renewed indefinitely or until a new hold request is placed by another user.
- Reservations and renewals on our website.
- Devices for **electronic books** are provided for 14 days.
- **Laptops** are provided for one-day use within the building premises.



TRAINING AND INFORMATION

- The Library organises **training sessions** on information resources throughout the academic year. You can apply for your course.
- Check the entire training offer on our website (**Study and learn / Training courses**).
- For any questions or bibliographic information ask at your library or at **PuntBIU** (**Library Information Point**).
- We also offer training and **support to researchers**.



STUDY HOURS AND READING ROOMS

- More than 3,500 reading posts available in 7 libraries at the UA.
- **Computers for public use** in the reading rooms of all libraries.
- **Regular opening hours:** Monday to Friday, from 8.30 a.m. to 9 p.m. Special holiday schedules and overtime hours are published on the web.
- **24-hour room** throughout the year except for 24th and 31st December.
- **Return book box** available at 24-hour room when libraries are closed.
- Free access to all libraries except for exceptional times in which UA ID card (TIU), ID card from other universities or license issued by BUA is needed.

COLLECTIONS

- **Recommended bibliography** for each course in study programmes and to support the development of scientific and research works in the UA.
- **Daily paper press** and digital press on our website.
- **Books and magazines**, e-books, e-journals, audiovisuals, maps, databases, etc.
- If you do not find what you need, the **Interlibrary Loan** unit can get it for you from another library. You can also ask for a purchase form called **desiderata**.



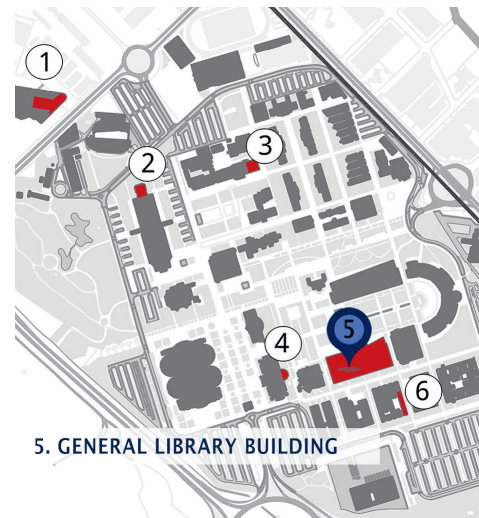
AND EVEN MORE
